



Recreation Program Leaders

(Temporary, Full-Time - June to August)

Located in the south-central region of B.C., the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen covers an area over 10,400 km² and is renowned for its orchards, vineyards and golf courses, as well as its widely varied landscape including deserts, mountains and valleys, and pristine lakes. Outdoor recreational opportunities are endless throughout the Regional District and residents enjoy a wide array of activities all year long.

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen is currently recruiting for temporary, full-time Recreation Program Leaders in the communities of Kaleden/Okanagan Falls, Naramata/West Bench and the Similkameen (Cawston, Hedley, Keremeos).

Reporting to the Recreation Manager, the Recreation Program Leader will be responsible for planning and facilitating “play” in the region. This is a summer work experience under the Canada Summer Job initiative. These positions seek to engage children and families in recreation in both structured and unstructured play settings. These individuals will be responsible for greeting participants, leading activities (or partnering with other agencies), ensuring the safety and enjoyment of participants, as well as organizing equipment, supplies and planning recreation and play activities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Program requires leaders between the ages of 15 and 30 years at the start of the employment.
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* for the duration of the employment.
- Experience working or volunteering with children in a recreational setting.
- Possess skills in recreational leadership and physical literacy.
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and marketing skills.
- Ability to pass and maintain a criminal record check.
- Holds a current Standard First-Aid Certificate.
- Holds a valid, Class 5 BC Driver’s licence.

These temporary, full time positions requires varied shifts that may include evenings, weekends and daytime working hours. These positions require thirty-five (35) hours per week from approximately mid-June to the end of August 2019. The hourly wage for the position is \$15.00.
